THE DOCTRINES OF THE BIBLE

Titus 2:1 But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:

Study 13

Church

Matthew 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

This is the first time the word church is mentioned in the Bible. Tonight we are going to look at what the Scripture has to say about church, God's house, and the role it should play in our lives.

1) JESUS STARTED THE CHURCH.

Matthew 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

2) JESUS OWNS THE CHURCH.

Matthew 16:18 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

3) JESUS IS THE HEAD OF THE CHURCH.

Éphesians 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.

HEAD (def) A chief; a principal person; a leader; a commander; one who has the first rank or place, and to whom others are subordinate; as the head of an army.

4) ONLY SAVED PEOPLE CAN JOIN THE CHURCH.

Ácts 2:47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

5) ONE NEEDS TO GET BAPTIZED AFTER SALVATION TO BE ADDED TO THE CHURCH.

Acts 2:41 Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.

6) BY DEFINITION THE CHURCH IS A LOCAL CALLED OUT ASSEMBLY OF BE-LIEVERS GATHERED TOGETHER FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD.

Hebrews 10:24 And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works: 25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Ephesians 4:11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

7) CHRISTIANS SHOULD NEVER FORSAKE CHURCH BUT INSTEAD BE FAITH-FUL TO ATTEND AND SUPPORT IT.

Hebrews 10:25 Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the day approaching.

Colossians 1:1 ¶ Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, and Timotheus our brother, 2 To the saints and faithful brethren in Christ which are at Colosse: Grace be unto you, and peace, from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Timothy 1:12 ¶ *And I thank Christ Jesus our Lord, who hath enabled me, for that he counted me faithful, putting me into the ministry;*

Revelation 2:8 ¶ And unto the angel of the church in Smyrna write; These things saith the first and the last, which was dead, and is alive;

9 I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan.

10 Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

11 He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches; He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death.

8) THERE WILL ALWAYS BE PERSECUTION ON THE CHURCH FROM THE WORLD.

Acts 8:1 ¶ And Saul was consenting unto his death. And at that time there was a great persecution against the church which was at Jerusalem; and they were all scattered abroad throughout the regions of Judaea and Samaria, except the apostles.

2 And devout men carried Stephen to his burial, and made great lamentation over him.

3 As for Saul, he made havock of the church, entering into every house, and haling men and women committed them to prison.

John 15:18 ¶ If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you.

19 If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.

20 Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep yours also.

21 But all these things will they do unto you for my name's sake, because they know not him that sent me.

9) GOD DESIRES FOR HIS CHURCH TO BE EDIFIED AND TO MULTIPLY.

Ácts 9:31 *Then had the churches rest throughout all Judaea and Galilee and Samaria, and were edified; and walking in the fear of the Lord, and in the comfort of the Holy Ghost, were multiplied.*

Acts 16:5 And so were the churches established in the faith, and increased in number daily.

10) THE CHURCH IS SUPPOSED TO PROPERLY REPRESENT CHRISTIANITY TO THE COMMUNITY.

Acts 11:26 And when he had found him, he brought him unto Antioch. And it came to pass, that a whole year they assembled themselves with the church, and taught much people. And the disciples were called Christians first in Antioch.

11) CHURCH IS SUPPOSED TO BE A HOUSE OF PRAYER.

Acts 12:5 ¶ Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him.

12) THE CHURCH CAN BEST ACCOMPLISH THE MISSION OF GOD BY BEING UNIFIED.

Acts $15:22 \ \P$ Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; namely, Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

13) JESUS PURCHASED THE CHURCH WITH HIS OWN BLOOD.

Acts 20:28 Take heed therefore unto yourselves, and to all the flock, over the which the Holy Ghost hath made you overseers, to feed the church of God, which he hath purchased with his own blood.

14) WE SHOULD STRIVE TO NEVER GIVE OFFENSE TO THE CHURCH IN HOW WE LIVE OR IN WHAT WE SAY.

1 Corinthians 10:31 Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.

32 Give none offence, neither to the Jews, nor to the Gentiles, nor to the church of God:

33 Even as I please all men in all things, not seeking mine own profit, but the profit of many, that they may be saved.

15) THE CHURCH SHOULD NOT BE CONTENTIOUS.

1 Corinthians 11:16 But if any man seem to be contentious, we have no such custom, neither the churches of God.

16) THE CHURCH SHOULD NEVER BE DIVIDED.

1 Corinthians 11:17 ¶ Now in this that I declare unto you I praise you not, that ye come together not for the better, but for the worse.

18 For first of all, when ye come together in the church, I hear that there be divisions among you; and I partly believe it.

17) THE CHURCH IS THE BODY OF CHRIST.

Colossians 1:18 And he is the head of the body, the church: who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead; that in all things he might have the preeminence.

18) GOD SET THE MEMBERS IN EACH CHURCH AS IT HATH PLEASED HIM.

1 Corinthians 12:18 But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

19) ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE CHURCH ARE EQUALLY IMPORTANT AND HAVE VITAL ROLES.

1 Corinthians 12:12 ¶ For as the body is one, and hath many members, and all the members of that one body, being many, are one body: so also is Christ.

13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

14 For the body is not one member, but many.

15 If the foot shall say, Because I am not the hand, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

16 And if the ear shall say, Because I am not the eye, I am not of the body; is it therefore not of the body?

17 If the whole body were an eye, where were the hearing? If the whole were hearing, where were the smelling?

18 But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

19 And if they were all one member, where were the body?

20 But now are they many members, yet but one body.

21 And the eye cannot say unto the hand, I have no need of thee: nor again the head to the feet, I have no need of you.

22 Nay, much more those members of the body, which seem to be more feeble, are necessary:

23 And those members of the body, which we think to be less honourable, upon these we bestow more abundant honour; and our uncomely parts have more abundant comeliness.

24 For our comely parts have no need: but God hath tempered the body together, having given more abundant honour to that part which lacked:

25 That there should be no schism in the body; but that the members should have the same care one for another.

26 And whether one member suffer, all the members suffer with it; or one member be honoured, all the members rejoice with it.

27 ¶ Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

20) GOD WANTS PEACE NOT CONFUSION TO BE IN HIS CHURCH.

1 Corinthians 14:33 For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.

21) GOD WANTS HIS CHURCH TO BE DECENT AND IN ORDER.

1 Corinthians 14:40 Let all things be done decently and in order.

22) GOD SET UP TITHES AND OFFERINGS TO SUPPORT THE CHURCH AND TO BE RECEIVED WEEKLY.

1 Corinthians 16:1 ¶ Now concerning the collection for the saints, as I have given order to the churches of Galatia, even so do ye.

2 Upon the first day of the week let every one of you lay by him in store, as God hath prospered him, that there be no gatherings when I come.

Malachi 3:8 Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

9 Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even this whole nation.

10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

23) GOD DESIRES FOR THE CHURCH TO BE INVOLVED IN WORLD WIDE MIS-SIONS.

2 Corinthians 8:1 ¶ Moreover, brethren, we do you to wit of the grace of God bestowed on the churches of Macedonia;

2 How that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality.

3 For to their power, I bear record, yea, and beyond their power they were willing of themselves;

4 Praying us with much intreaty that we would receive the gift, and take upon us the fellowship of the ministering to the saints.

5 And this they did, not as we hoped, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God.

6 Insomuch that we desired Titus, that as he had begun, so he would also finish in you the same grace also. 7 \P Therefore, as ye abound in every thing, in faith, and utterance, and knowledge, and in all diligence, and in your love to us, see that ye abound in this grace also.

24) THE TWO OFFICES OF THE CHURCH ARE PASTOR AND DEACON.

Ephesians 4:11 And he gave some, apostles; and some, prophets; and some, evangelists; and some, pastors and teachers;

1 Timothy 3:1 ¶ *This is a true saying, If a man desire the office of a bishop, he desireth a good work.*

1 Timothy 3:8 ¶ *Likewise must the deacons be grave, not doubletongued, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre;*

9 Holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience.

10 And let these also first be proved; then let them use the office of a deacon, being found blameless.

25) THE TWO ORDINANCES OF THE CHURCH ARE BAPTISM AND THE LORD'S SUPPER.

Ephesinas 4:4 There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; 5 One Lord, one faith, one baptism,

1 Corinthians 11:20 When ye come together therefore into one place, this is not to eat the Lord's supper. 21 For in eating every one taketh before other his own supper: and one is hungry, and another is drunken. 22 What? have ye not houses to eat and to drink in? or despise ye the church of God, and shame them that have not? What shall I say to you? shall I praise you in this? I praise you not.

23 ¶ For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread:

24 And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me.

25 After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me.

26 For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come.

27 Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord.

28 But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup.

29 For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

30 For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep.

26) THE CHURCH IS THE PILLAR & GROUND OF THE TRUTH.

1 Timothy 3:15 But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.

27) THE CHURCH IS TO GIVE GLORY TO GOD.

Ephesians3:21 Unto him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.
