THE DOCTRINES OF THE BIBLE

Titus 2:1 But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:

Study 41

SIN

Tonight we will discuss SIN as it is taught in the Scriptures.

1) SIN FIRST APPEARED IN THE SCRIPTURES IN GENESIS CHAPTER 3.

Genesis 2:16 ¶ *And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, Of every tree of the garden thou mayest freely eat:*

17 But of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, thou shalt not eat of it: for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die.

Genesis 3:1 ¶ Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden?

2 And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden:

3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die.

4 And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die:

5 For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.

 $6 \$ And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

8 And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.

2) THE PENALTY FOR SIN IS DEATH.

Romans 6:23 For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Romans 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

James 1:15 Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death.

Ezekiel 18:4 Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die.

3) THE SECOND DEATH IS THE ETERNAL PENALTY FOR SIN.

Revelation 20:11 ¶ *And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.*

12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

4) THERE ARE MANY DIFFERENT CLASSIFICATIONS OF SIN.

A. SIN (def) The voluntary departure of a moral agent from a known rule of rectitude or duty, prescribed by God; any violation of a divine command. Sin is either a positive act in which a known divine law is violated, or it is the voluntary neglect to obey a positive divine command, or a rule of duty clearly implied in such command.

B. TRANSGRESSION (def) Fault; offense; crime.

C. INIQUITY (def) injustice

D. UNRIGHTEOUSNESS (def) a single unjust act, but more generally, when applied to persons, it denotes an habitual course of disobedience.

E. EVIL (def) Having bad qualities of a natural kind; mischievous; having qualities which tend to injury, or to produce mischief. Having bad qualities of a moral kind; corrupt; perverse; wrong; as evil thoughts; evil deeds; evil speaking, producing sorrow, distress, injury or calamity.

F. WICKEDNESS (def) corrupt and perverse manners, practices that directly oppose God and what God endorses.

5) SIN IS IN OUR NATURE.

Romans 5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

1 Corinthians 15:22 For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.

44 It is sown a natural body; it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.

45 And so it is written, The first man Adam was made a living soul; the last Adam was made a quickening spirit.

46 Howbeit that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural; and afterward that which is spiritual.

47 The first man is of the earth, earthy: the second man is the Lord from heaven.

6) THE DEVIL IS THE GREAT TEMPTER OF SIN.

Matthew 4:1 ¶ *Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.*

2 Timothy 2:24 And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, 25 In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth;

26 And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will.

1 Peter 5:8 ¶ *Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour:*

9 Whom resist stedfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world.

1 John 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.

7) WE CAN PROTECT OURSELVES FROM THE DEVIL WITH THE ARMOR OF GOD.

Ephesians 6:10 ¶ *Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.*

11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; 15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

A. LOINS OF TRUTH— protection of moral purity and virtue, good standards and convictions.

B. BREASTPLATE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS— protection of heart and affections, guarding what you love, not following your heart but guiding your heart.

C. GOSPEL SHOES— for going to the lost and spreading the Gospel of peace, carrying the Gospel into all the world so you don't get tripped up with needless activities.

D. SHIELD OF FAITH— living by faith, not by sight, belief in God and His Word.

E. HELMET OF SALVATION— knowing what salvation is and knowing that you are personally saved.

F. SWORD OF THE SPIRIT— the Word of God, the mind of Christ, study and meditation.

G. MOUTHPIECE OF PRAYER— praying always with supplication for the saints and casting all your care upon the Lord.

H. VISOR OF WATCHING— looking out for danger and seeing life through the eyes of God.

8) THE WORLD IS THE HARVEST FIELD OF SIN.

1 John 2:15 Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

17 And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever.

9) HAVE A PLAN TO OVERCOME SIN.

1 John 4:4 ¶ Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, than he that is in the world.

A. DECIDE TO RESIST TEMPTATION

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

B. DO NOT BE IN A SITUATION WHERE YOU CAN EASILY GIVE IN TO TEMPTATION

Genesis 39:7 ¶ And it came to pass after these things, that his master's wife cast her eyes upon Joseph; and she said, Lie with me.

8 But he refused, and said unto his master's wife, Behold, my master wotteth not what is with me in the house, and he hath committed all that he hath to my hand;

9 There is none greater in this house than I; neither hath he kept back any thing from me but thee, because thou art his wife: how then can I do this great wickedness, and sin against God?

10 And it came to pass, as she spake to Joseph day by day, that he hearkened not unto her, to lie by her, or to be with her.

11 And it came to pass about this time, that Joseph went into the house to do his business; and there was none of the men of the house there within.

12 And she caught him by his garment, saying, Lie with me: and he left his garment in her hand, and fled, and got him out.

C. DO NOT BE AROUND THOSE WHO ARE SINNING

1 Corinthians 15:33 Be not deceived: evil communications corrupt good manners.

D. DO NOT LET YOURSELF THINK ON THAT TEMPTATION

2 Corinthians 10:5 Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;

E. MEMORIZE VERSES THAT HELP YOU OVERCOME TEMPTATION

Psalm 119:11 ¶ Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.

F. ASK GOD TO GIVE YOU VICTORY

Matthew 6:9 ¶ *After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.* 10 *Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.*

11 Give us this day our daily bread.

12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen.

10) ONE DAY IN HEAVEN, WE WILL BE FREE FROM SIN.

1 Corinthians 15:51 ¶ Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed, 52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.

54 So when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.

55 O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?

56 The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law.

57 But thanks be to God, which giveth us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 John 3:1 ¶ Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

2 Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

3 And every man that hath this hope in him purifieth himself, even as he is pure.

Revelation 21:1 ¶ *And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea.*

2 And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

4 And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain: for the former things are passed away.

5 And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold, I make all things new. And he said unto me, Write: for these words are true and faithful.

Revelation 22:1 ¶ And he shewed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

2 In the midst of the street of it, and on either side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bare twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

3 And there shall be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be in it; and his servants shall serve him:
