

## WEDNESDAY EVENING BIBLE STUDY

### THE DOCTRINES OF THE BIBLE

*Titus 2:1 But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:*

#### Study 5

#### Jesus Christ

*John 20:31 But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.*

##### 1) JESUS IS THE MESSIAH.

*John 4:25 The woman saith unto him, I know that Messias cometh, which is called Christ: when he is come, he will tell us all things.*

*26 Jesus saith unto her, I that speak unto thee am he.*

##### 2) JESUS IS THE SON OF GOD.

*Matthew 14:33 Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God.*

##### 3) JESUS IS HUMAN AS THE SON OF MAN.

*Luke 19:10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.*

##### 4) HE WAS IN THE BEGINNING.

*John 1:1 ¶ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.*

*2 The same was in the beginning with God.*

##### 5) HE IS THE WORD.

*John 1:1 ¶ In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.*

This means that He has always existed as the Word but He did not have a body until He was born.

*1 John 5:7 For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.*

##### 6) HE MADE ALL THINGS.

*John 1:3 All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made.*

*Revelation 4:11 Thou art worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honour and power: for thou hast created all things, and for thy pleasure they are and were created.*

##### 7) HE BECAME FLESH.

*John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.*

*1 Timothy 3:16 And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory.*

##### 8) HE WAS BORN OF A VIRGIN AND ONLY BEGOTTEN OF THE FATHER.

*Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.*

*John 3:16 For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.*

##### 9) HE IS CALLED EMMANUEL WHICH IS GOD WITH US.

*Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel.*

*Matthew 1:23 Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.*

##### 10) HE APPEARED MANY TIMES IN THE OLD TESTAMENT.

*Daniel 3:25 He answered and said, Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt; and the form of the fourth is like the Son of God.*

*Joshua 5:13 ¶ And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted up his eyes and looked, and, behold, there stood a man over against him with his sword drawn in his hand: and Joshua went unto him, and said unto him, Art thou for us, or for our adversaries?*

*14 And he said, Nay; but as captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto him, What saith my lord unto his servant?*

*15 And the captain of the LORD'S host said unto Joshua, Loose thy shoe from off thy foot; for the place whereon thou standest is holy. And Joshua did so.*

*Genesis 32:24 ¶ And Jacob was left alone; and there wrestled a man with him until the breaking of the day.*

*25 And when he saw that he prevailed not against him, he touched the hollow of his thigh; and the hollow of Jacob's thigh was out of joint, as he wrestled with him.*

*26 And he said, Let me go, for the day breaketh. And he said, I will not let thee go, except thou bless me.*

*27 And he said unto him, What is thy name? And he said, Jacob.*

*28 And he said, Thy name shall be called no more Jacob, but Israel: for as a prince hast thou power with God and with men, and hast prevailed.*

*29 And Jacob asked him, and said, Tell me, I pray thee, thy name. And he said, Wherefore is it that thou dost ask after my name? And he blessed him there.*

*30 And Jacob called the name of the place Peniel: for I have seen God face to face, and my life is preserved.*

### **11) HE CAME THE FIRST TIME TO SAVE SINNERS.**

*1 Timothy 1:15 This is a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.*

### **12) HE DIED AS THE SUBSTITUTE FOR OUR SINS.**

*1 Corinthians 15:1 ¶ Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;*

*2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.*

*3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;*

*4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:*

*1 John 2:1 ¶ My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous:*

*2 And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world.*

### **13) HE ROSE FROM THE DEAD.**

*Matthew 28:1 ¶ In the end of the sabbath, as it began to dawn toward the first day of the week, came Mary Magdalene and the other Mary to see the sepulchre.*

*2 And, behold, there was a great earthquake: for the angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat upon it.*

*3 His countenance was like lightning, and his raiment white as snow:*

*4 And for fear of him the keepers did shake, and became as dead men.*

*5 And the angel answered and said unto the women, Fear not ye: for I know that ye seek Jesus, which was crucified.*

*6 He is not here: for he is risen, as he said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.*

*7 And go quickly, and tell his disciples that he is risen from the dead; and, behold, he goeth before you into Galilee; there shall ye see him: lo, I have told you.*

*8 And they departed quickly from the sepulchre with fear and great joy; and did run to bring his disciples word.*

### **14) HE IS COMING AGAIN.**

*John 14:1 ¶ Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.*

*2 In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.*

*3 And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am,*

*there ye may be also.*

*1 John 2:28 ¶ And now, little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming.*

### **15) HE IS THE ONLY WAY TO HEAVEN.**

*John 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.*

*Acts 4:12 Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.*

### **16) HE IS THE LAMB OF GOD.**

*John 1:29 ¶ The next day John seeth Jesus coming unto him, and saith, Behold the Lamb of God, which taketh away the sin of the world.*

### **17) HE IS THE I AM.**

*John 8:56 Your father Abraham rejoiced to see my day: and he saw it, and was glad.*

*57 Then said the Jews unto him, Thou art not yet fifty years old, and hast thou seen Abraham?*

*58 Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Before Abraham was, I am.*

### **18) HE IS THE MIGHTY GOD AND OUR SAVIOUR.**

*Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace.*

*Titus 2:10 Not purloining, but shewing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Saviour in all things.*

*13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;*

### **19) HE IS THE HEAD OF THE CHURCH.**

*Ephesians 5:23 For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the saviour of the body.*

### **20) HIS NAME IS ABOVE ALL NAMES.**

*Philippians 2:5 Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus:*

*6 Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:*

*7 But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:*

*8 And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.*

*9 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:*

*10 That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;*

*11 And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.*

### **21) HE HAS BEEN GIVEN ALL POWER, AUTHORITY, IN HEAVEN AND IN EARTH.**

*Matthew 28:18 And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth.*

### **22) HE IS THE FULNESS OF THE GODHEAD BODILY.**

*Colossians 2:8 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.*

*9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.*

### **23) HE IS ALWAYS THE SAME.**

*Hebrews 13:8 Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.*
